Nagles, Sonora, Mexico, Nov. 12.—Crossing the street from the United States into Mexico today, William Bayard Hale, personal representative of President Wilson, met the constitutionalist chief, General Venustiano Carranza, and presented to him a definite proposal.

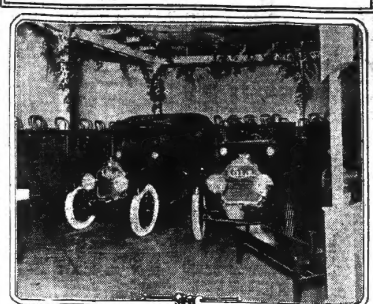


Exhibit of Cole Motor Company, showing the new 1914 models.

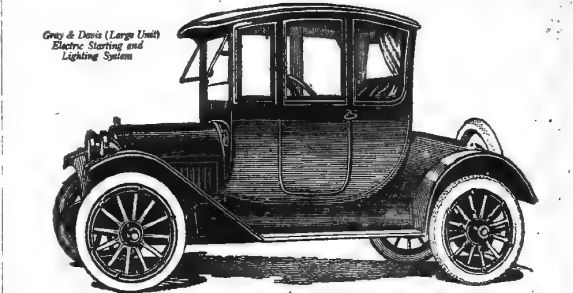
