She stopped and saw the form of a man crouched behind the curtains. Another man was crouching in a dark corner of the room. Without the slightest hesitation she had seen either the intruders or a man who had been in the room. Mrs. Pomeroy proceeded to the next room, opening the door, and there retraced her steps to the stairs.

Making sure the back door was locked, she returned to the living room. She could not see, she left the rest of the room through the door which she had locked. Georgian Will Be Succeeded on Commerce Commission by Ex-Gov. Glenn of North Carolina.

Mr. Clements' term will expire on December 31 next. He retires after twenty-one years of service on the board. His place will be taken by Governor B. B. Glenn, of North Carolina. Much political importance attaches to the new appointment. Governor Glenn was a prospective candidate for the senate in North Carolina against Senator Overman. He has a strong personal following and would have been a formidable opponent.

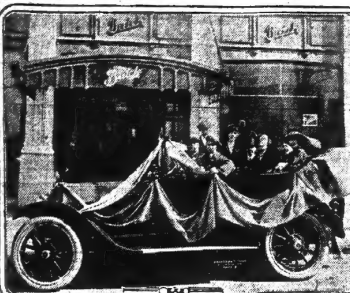

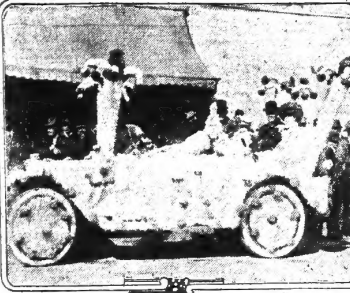

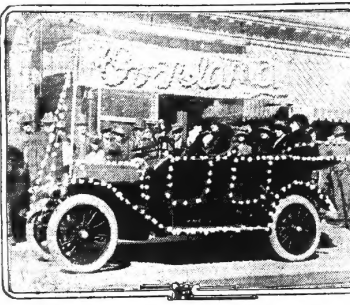
