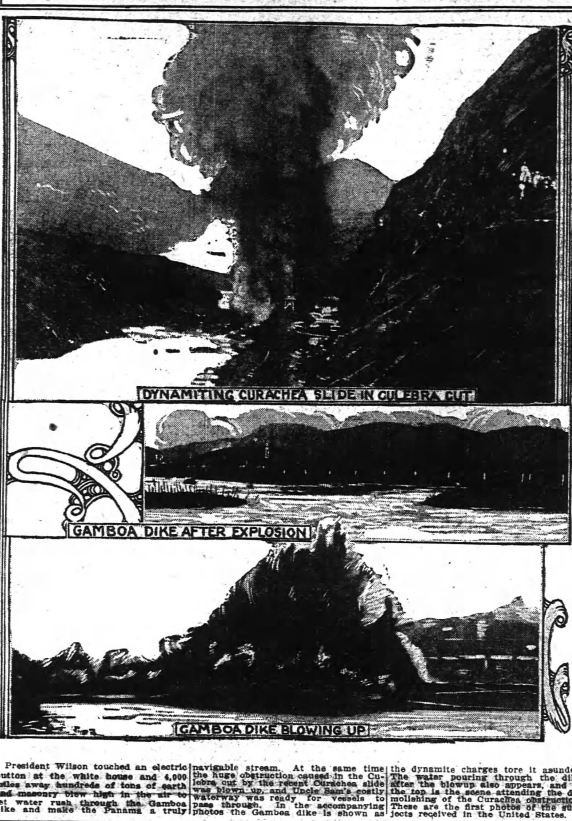

FIVE RESCUED MINERS UNABLE TO TELL FATE OF OTHERS ENTOMBED

Rescue Work Being Pushed But There Is No Hope of Reaching the Buried Men Before Tonight—Some Believe That the Entombed Men Will Be Found Alive.

Denver, Colo., October 22.—Between 230 and 280 miners were entombed by an explosion in mine No. 3 of the Stag Canon Fuel company at Dawson, N. M., at 2 o'clock this afternoon.

Accounts from Dawson and Reno were uncertain as to the possibility of rescuing any of the men alive, while a statement from El Paso, Texas, expressed hope that most of the entombed men would be found alive.

Immediate Relief Work. Immediate relief work was undertaken by men from the night shift and neighboring mine. Appeals for aid started across of experienced miners from Trinidad and the southern coal camps shortly after 6 o'clock and they were expected to reach Dawson before midnight.

J. C. Roberts, superintendent of federal mine rescue stations in the Rocky mountain division, began immediate preparations to leave for Dawson to direct the rescue work. He also telegraphed Pittsburgh, Kan., and Stock River, Wyo., for the rescue car stationed at those points.

RESCUERS ARE WORKING IN THE WRECKED MINE

Dawson, N. M., October 22.—Two hundred and thirty miners, according to unofficial estimates, were entombed in shaft No. 3 of the Stag Canon mine when an explosion occurred in the property at 2 o'clock this afternoon.

Rescuers were called from all parts of the southern Colorado coal fields. The day shift working in shaft No. 3 was called to the surface.

Immediately after the explosion all shafts were closed and the rescue work drilling through the debris, which was about 100 feet deep, was begun.

By 10 o'clock tonight the rescuers had penetrated more than 100 feet into the mouth of the mine and reached the mine where they had been working.

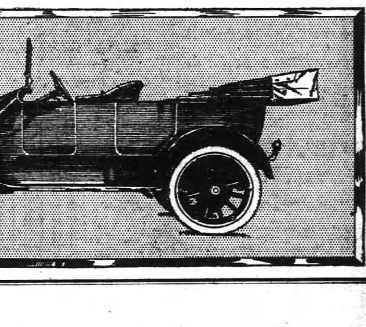
