

Unfortunately, officers of less discretion acted differently and the whole affair has been turned into a loke-except to the two young women who have been made the real sufferers. It will clarify the atmosphere wonderfully if Chief Beavers will make it clear that the "capitol-steps" policy is not the policy of his department. The police commission should also make that fact clear. It is, indeed, a duty that both the chief and the board owe to themselves and the city to make clear this policy. Neither one wants a general revulsion of sentiment that may confuse crime with innocence, and vice may confuse crime with innocence, and vice may confuse crime with innocence, and vice wersa, and undo the careful work of the

Chief Beavers and his men have don splendid public service. They are fully capacitated to continue to do splendid pub-lic service. But that may only be done by keeping clear the sense of values in the public mind. Chief Beavers and the overwhelm-ing majority of his men would stand for neither.
