

Prospects for a new trial for Leo M. Frank were made much brighter Wednesday atternoon by Judge Roan's certification of the defense's description of the disorder and demonstration in the courtroom on various occasions during Frank's trial. The judge's official approval of this fact as a ground for argument will give the defense an invaluable advantage when the arguments begin, and also before the Supreme Court in the event that it becomes necessary to carry the fight for Frank's life to the higher tribunal. The facts to which Judge Roan certified were contained in the defense's charge that immediately on the announcement that Conley's testimory, taken to show perversion and immorality and acts wholly disassociated from the charge of murder, was to stand, there were immediate cheers, clapping of hands and stamping of feet in the courtroom.
